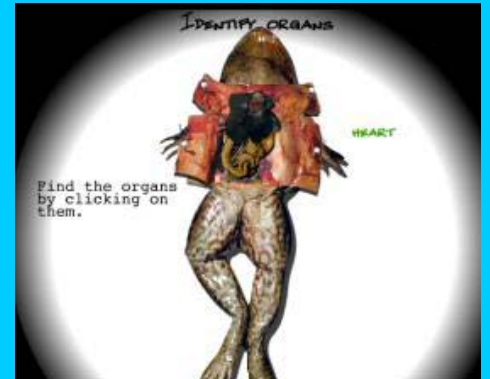
There are different sorts of things I like about the size mostly because it's only 2 1/2 to 5 1/2 so it's really small and cute!
